United **Neighborhood Centers' Project Hope Summer Camp Registration Dates** Set in Carbondale

Carbondale, PA – United Neighborhood Centers of Northeastern Pennsylvania (UNC) will begin registration in Carbondale for its 40th annual summer camp, Project Hope, on Monday, May 10 from 3 p.m. until 6 p.m. for children ages 5 through 12. Families may also register on Wednesday, May 19 and Thursday, May 27, from 3 p.m. until 6 p.m. All registrations will take place at the Carbondale Senior Community Center, 66 N. Church Street.

To enroll in Project Hope families must provide proof of income, number of children in household, **children's ages and date of birth.**

Registration will also take place in Scranton at UNC's Community Services Building, 410 Olive Street, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. and Thursdays, 9 a.m. until 6 p.m. throughout May.

Project Hope will take place July 6 through August 6, 2010, Monday through Friday at Camp St. Andrew in the endless mountains of Tunkhannock. The site is located on 550 acres and features fields, woods, a lake and **pool for the children's enjoyment. Activities throughout the week will** include archery, arts and crafts, boating, kayaking, swimming, a climbing wall and adventure learning course (for children 11 through 12).

Funding by CCIS/Title 20 and DPA is accepted. Special regular fees are available for low-income families.
