Tie-Break Criteria

In the event of a tied renewal project score, projects will be ranked according to the following local priorities:

- 1. Veteran Programs
- 2. RRH \rightarrow TH Conversion Projects
- 3. Established Street Outreach Providers

If two projects fall under the same local priority category (e.g., two RRH \rightarrow TH Conversion Projects), the CoC will compare each project's 2023 APR data using the following tie-break sequence:

- 1. Secured Permanent Housing
- 2. Maintained or Increased Employment Income
- ${\bf 3.\,Maintained\,or\,Increased\,Non-Employment\,Income}$
- 4. Returns to Homelessness
